GPA is calculated by adding up the number of Quality Points earned in each class and dividing by the number of credits attempted.

$$\text{GPA} = (\text{total quality points earned}) / (\text{total attempted credits})$$

** all attempts count in your high school GPA unless you retake the exact same course to replace a D or F with a high grade. The original D or F will always show on your transcript but will not be included in your GPA.

Quality Points: (for each 0.5 credit class the quality points are half, for each 1.0 credit course the full quality points are earned)
